

**Public Hearing
Overview
May 17, 2005**

The City of Weatherby Lake Board of Aldermen held a public hearing on Tuesday, May 17, 2005 at 6:45 P.M. at City Hall, 7200 NW Eastside Drive, Weatherby Lake, Missouri for consideration of a rate increase for water services.

The hearing was called to order by Mayor Michael Henderson, with Aldermen Moratz, Clark, Cummings and Rittenhouse present. Three (3) residents were also present.

Discussion turned to the issue of the increase currently proposed at 10%. The City of Weatherby Lake received an increase of 9.2% from Kansas City, Missouri. 9.2% is the pass through cost with the remaining .08% to be used to offset related maintenance costs, up-grades etc. As part of the proposed capital expense report submitted by the Director of Public Works approximately 25 houses remain with 2" lines that will need to be up-graded with the completion of the new water tower. The .08% may have to be amended at some point to address these types of issues.

The proposed rate changes are as follows:

IN-CITY RATES

1. \$7.26 per 1,000 for the first 4,000 gallons
2. \$2.20 per 1,000 gallons thereafter

OUT-OF-CITY-RATES

1. \$14.41 per 1,000 for the first 4,000 gallons
2. \$3.56 per 1,000 gallons thereafter
