BOARD OF ALDERMEN
SEWER RATE WORK SESSION

The work session of the Weatherby Lake Board of Aldermen was called to order by Mayor Mike Henderson on Monday, July 11, 2005 at City Hall, 7200 NW Eastside Drive, Weatherby Lake, Platte County, Missouri at 5:30 P.M.

Aldermen present were: Clark, Cummings, Rittenhouse and Moratz.

Also present were: George Lowman (Director of Public Works), Linda Eckerle (utility billing clerk) and three (3) members of the public.

The work session began with the overview of the audit report for the period ending December 31, 2004, which indicated a loss of approximately \$27,000.00. The current structure will continue the producing a loss with intervention.

Mr. Lowman provided board members with issues relating to the sewer system that will/are in need of attention (bio-filters, line replacement/repair etc.).

Discussion continued around potential increases for the sewer system as a single system (no distinction between gravity or grinder).

A consensus of a minimum of \$7.00 per month and a maximum of \$10.00 per month will be evaluated at a public hearing scheduled for August 16, 2005 at 6:30 P.M.

Clark moved, second by Rittenhouse to adjourn. Yeas: Cummings, Moratz, Clark and Rittenhouse. Motion passed unanimously.
