

DRAFT MINUTES  
January 10, 2018

The regularly scheduled Board meeting of the City of Weatherby Lake Board of Aldermen was called to order by Mayor Patrick Botbyl on Wednesday, January 10, 2018 at City Hall 7200 NW Eastside Drive, Weatherby Lake, Platte County, Missouri at 7:02p.m.

Aldermen present were: Clark, Richmond, Footer and Finn.

Also present were: John Reddoch, city attorney and four (4) members of the public.

**Mayor's Communication to the Board**

Mayor thanked the Garden Club for the decorations on all city monuments and thanked Alderman Finn for City Hall decorations.

He thanked the police and public works departments for the storm prep done during the holiday season.

The City is working with our IT person and others concerning upgrading the internet service and installing a new phone system in City Hall.
